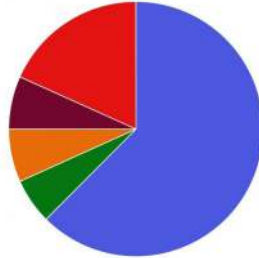

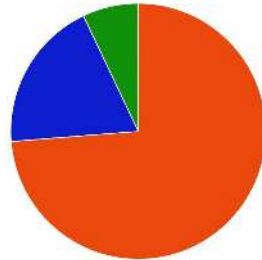

YFC introduced a new logo recently. It represents our model of relational ministry. Each circle symbolizes a story: **GOD'S STORY, OUR STORY** and **THEIR STORY**.
