

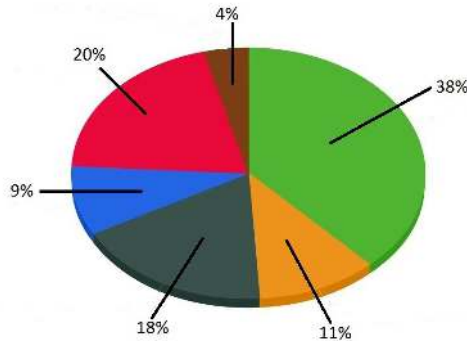

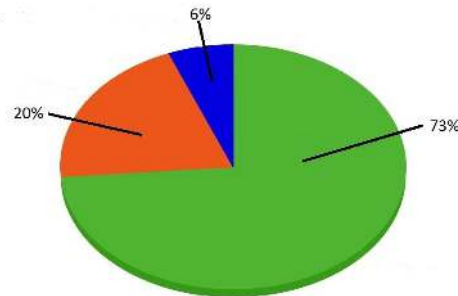

LAUNCHED a Campus Life Club in Gahanna. This is our first Campus Life outreach in suburban Columbus.
